Recital includes works by Bach, Wagner, Pachelbel, Whitlock and Litaize.

A native of Yorkshire, **Jack Spencer** has left his homeland behind, and has spent a gap year as organ scholar at Rochester Cathedral. Prior to this he was organ scholar at Leeds Minster. From next month, Jack will be taking up the junior organ scholarship at Queens' College, Cambridge, where he will also attempt to read for the Natural Sciences tripos. He currently studies with Stephen Farr, having previously learnt with Graham Barber, Daniel Justin and Thomas Leech. As well as masterclasses with other eminent performers, he was fortunate enough to have participated in the masterclass with Dame Gillian Weir at Hexham Abbey as part of last years IAO convention. In March of 2013 he took his ATCL diploma in organ performance, in which he received a distinction. He has been lucky enough to have played in many of the cathedrals and college chapels in the UK, as well as famous instruments in America and Continental Europe. An active recitalist, venues this year include the cathedrals of Southwark, Bradford, Ripon, and Rochester. Jack is an advocate of lesser known works from the organ repertoire, and, among other things, is performing Whitlock's
