### ASSISTED DYING BILL POSTCARDS

As you may know there is a very important debate taking place in the House of Commons on 11 September 2015 on a Private Members Bill to legalise assisted suicide. There are many MPs in the House of Commons who are paying close attention to the views of their constituents, and it is very important that we should play our part as much as we can to make our voices heard. There are postcards at the back of the Cathedral and the Crypt and they have been designed to be simple and effective in pointing out the grave risks in this Bill, and they can be signed by anyone of any faith or none who opposes the legalisation of assisted suicide. Please take one of the postcards and either send it yourself, or give them out to colleagues and friends to send to your local MP. It is appreciated that the middle of the summer holidays is the least convenient time to receive these postcards. The timing of the debate – 11 September – leaves little option but to act now. Please alert yourselves to this issue and either write directly or send a postcard. Thank you. Please collect a postcard from the back of the Cathedral or the Crypt.

## VOLUNTEERS REQUIRED

Beanstalk is a national children's literacy charity that supports over 1,400 children in the North West through recruiting and training reading helpers. Each reading helper supports 3 children, on a one-to-one basis for at least a school year and therefore provides much needed consistency and support to the children. Volunteers go into school twice a week during school hours for 90 minutes on each occasion and sessions are a mixture of literacy, conversation and play. Sessions are therefore child-led, and aimed at encouraging the children and boosting their reading skills as well as their wider emotional wellbeing and confidence. **James Luxton – Liverpool Metropolitan Cathedral**

Recital includes works by Bach, Daquin, Camonin, Franck and Durufle.

**James Luxton** is Assistant Director of Music at Liverpool Metropolitan Cathedral. He studied piano, violin and organ at the Birmingham Conservatoire Junior Department, continuing there for a B Mus (Hons) studying with Professor David Saint and Henry Fairs, and graduated with First Class Honours in 2011. In the same year, whilst studying on the Personal Study Programme, he gained the Associateship diploma of the Royal College of Organists (ARCO) with the Limpus, Frederick Shinn, Durrant, Doris Wookey and Dr F J Read prizes; he obtained the diploma of Fellowship (FRCO) the following year. During his time at the Conservatoire, James held organ scholarships at St Chad's Metropolitan Cathedral and Town

Hall and Symphony Hall, Birmingham.

James's subsequent posts have included: Tutor of Organ and Music Theory at the Conservatoire Junior Department, Assistant Director of Music at St Peter's Collegiate Church, Wolverhampton, Musician-in-Residence at Old Swinford Hospital, Stourbridge, and in 2012, was appointed Sub-Assistant Organist of Worcester Cathedral. In Worcester, James accompanied the Cathedral Choir for daily services, directed the Cathedral Voluntary Choir at home and abroad, and took part in the 2014 Worcester Three Choirs Festival, performing with the world-renowned Philharmonia Orchestra.

One of the highlights in James's career includes playing the organ for Pope Benedict XVI's visit to the UK in 2010 (at Oscott College, Birmingham - broadcast live on television. For this, James received a gold medallion.

He has recently broadcast on BBC Radio. In recognition of his contribution to the profession of music, James was awarded Honorary Membership of Birmingham Conservatoire (HonBC) in June this year.
