This photographic competition has been organised by the Liverpool Archdiocese Secondary Schools' Partnership. Schools within the Partnership are located across the North West region in Liverpool, Sefton, Knowsley, St Helens, Lancashire, Wigan, Warrington and Halton.

All our schools were invited to submit entries from the lower school (Years 7 to 9) and the upper school (Year 10 and 11 or to Year 13 for schools with sixth forms). Each photograph is accompanied by a piece of descriptive text that gives additional meaning to the photographs on show.
