ST TERESA BENEDICTA OF THE CROSS

Celebrates her Feast Day on Tuesday of this week. Edith Stein was born of Jewish parents in 1891, becoming an influential philosopher following her extensive studies at major German universities. Following her conversion to Catholicism she became a major force in German intellectual life, entering the Discalced Carmelites in 1933. Sister Teresa Benedicta was arrested by the Nazi regime in 1942, along with all Catholics of Jewish extraction and

transported by cattle train to the death camp of Auschwitz. She died in the gas chambers at Auschwitz that same year.

Strawberry Field – the ideal outing for Christian groups

Strawberry Field is a stunning, revitalised site that houses an exhibition, café, gift shop and a Training Centre for adults with Learning Difficulties and other barriers to employment. The award-winning exhibition tells the fascinating story of the place and its people, the connection with The Salvation Army and John Lennon, and the ongoing work of the centre in serving the needs of the local community. In addition, it houses the piano on which John Lennon composed and recorded the song 'Imagine'. (The piano is currently on loan from the estate of the late George Michael.) The new visitor centre also offers a Prayer Space, beautiful gardens for quiet contemplation and a café to refresh both body and soul through beautiful food and spectacular views. A new addition to the garden in 2022 is a 'state of the art' bandstand which is currently in the final stages of completion. Our Fresh Expression team is available to facilitate the visit of Christian groups, who may like to embrace opportunities for prayer and reflection.
