### WORLD MISSION SUNDAY

On 23 October, the entire Catholic Church will be unified in prayer and support of mission. Each year, World Mission Sunday is coordinated by Missio and celebrated in every Catholic community in the world. It is a moment of grace to express solidarity with our brothers and sisters in Christ who are living in situations of poverty, violence and oppression.

World Mission Sunday is vital to the growth of the Church and the spread of the Gospel in predominantly impoverished and remote areas overseas. The theme the Holy Father has chosen this year is: 'You shall be my witnesses (Acts 1:8).

In his message for World Mission Sunday, he says: 'The same Spirit which guides the universal Church also inspires ordinary men and women to undertake extraordinary missions. And so it was that two hundred years ago, a young French woman - Blessed Pauline Jaricot – founded the Association for the Propagation of the Faith (Missio's APF). She established a network of prayer and fundraising for missionaries, so that the faithful could actively participate in God's mission "to the ends of the earth". This brilliant idea gave rise to the annual celebration of World Mission Sunday'.

#### **MICAH FOODBANK**

At the moment Micah Liverpool is in need of additional food donations. From the 1st of June to the 1st of September, they distributed 4,709 parcels to those using the emergency food pantries based at St Vincent De Paul and St Bride's Church. They have received great support from regular donors which has enabled them to continue to support the people using the foodbanks but they do expect to see a rise in the need for their services over the next few months. With continual cost of living rises and the uncertainty of fuel prices, they fear that their food aid services will be stretched further than they have ever been before. Micah are working closely with food provision partners across the city and nationally through Feeding Liverpool and the Independent Food Aid Network to try to mitigate these circumstances.
