LENTEN MUSIC

Join us this Sunday (3rd March) at the Metropolitan Cathedral when our boy choristers and Lay Clerks will sing the rarely performed 'The Seven Last Words of Christ on the Cross' by César Franck. The Seven Last Words is a devotional work written in 1859, but never performed until the work was discovered in 1977. Franck was not the only composer to set the seven last words of Jesus (actually, sentences not words!) but Franck was unusual in that he sought to expand on the brief text by supplementing other biblical and liturgical texts reflecting the fact that Franck was a parish church organist steeped in the Catholic liturgical tradition. The offering takes place at 3.00pm in the Cathedral and as is free to attend - all are welcome.
