"The terrible murders of Alice Dasilva Aquiar. Bebe King and Elsie Dot Stancombe shocked and appalled people of every faith - and those of no faith - across Mersevside, and indeed the country.

As we approach one week since that terrible day, they and their families should remain very much at the forefront of all our thoughts.

While this should be a time for guiet reflection and remembrance, since Monday, too many people have sought to use the tragedy to create division and hate.

It can - and has - left communities in fear and has put people in danger.

While the events of this week may continue to shake our belief in humanity, it remains intact.
