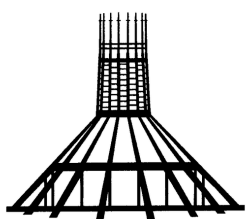

Sunday: Solemn Mass at 11.00 and Choral Evening Prayer at 15.00

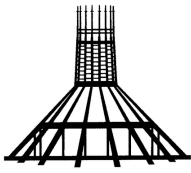
