CHRISM MASS 2025

Wednesday 16 April

The Chrism Mass, which this year will take place on Wednesday 16 April at 7.30pm in the Metropolitan Cathedral is usually the largest annual gathering of archdiocesan clergy and faithful throughout the year. At the Mass, Archbishop Malcolm blesses the holy oils that are used throughout the archdiocese for celebrations of the sacraments in the next year. He does this in the presence of priests, deacons and lay faithful.

Additionally, the Archbishop invites the priests of the archdiocese to renew the promises they made at their ordination: to dedicate their life in service to the Church - to preach the Gospel and teach the Catholic faith, to faithfully celebrate the sacraments and to pray for God's people.

Everyone is welcome and encouraged to attend this liturgy enhanced by the Cathedral Choir, and experience the richness of our local church, especially if you have never been before. Any queries please contact Claire Hanlon at c.hanlon@metcathedral.org.uk

Micah's foodbanks continue to see a similar number of people each week who are experiencing food poverty. In February, a total of 1105 food parcels were distributed. We are beginning to see people from the foodbanks attend Micah's community markets where a £2 charge is made for a choice of up to 15 items of food. We know that the need is great and resources are limited. Please do pray for Micah as we continue to support people who experience poverty on a daily basis. We are grateful for our volunteers who give of their time regularly and care for those who attend our food spaces, as well as those who faithfully donate.

Micah's Recruitability Programme continues to see participants grow in confidence as they are supported to find employment, continue volunteer work and gain further qualifications. On 25 March, Micah's Partner Organisation, Zarach, delivered its 500th bed to children in Liverpool. Zarach's Liverpool Hub with Micah was established in June 2023 by Hazel and Alex, who generously and faithfully give of their time and skills on a voluntary basis. Whilst Zarach works to end child bed poverty, the impact of the initiative goes far beyond just providing a bed. It gives children the foundation for a better future. Better sleep leads to better concentration at school, improved well-being and greater self-esteem.

VISITING CHOIR

We are delighted to be able to welcome a visiting choir to sing at Solemn Mass and Choral Evening prayer on Sunday 6 April. Led by director, Marc Murray, The Rawstorne Singers (based in Preston) are a mixed-voice chamber choir of around 35 singers who perform local concerts of both religious and secular works and deputise for Cathedral choirs at services across the UK and Ireland, and was established by Michael Sands in 1980. Taking its name from Bishop Atherton Gwilym Rawstorne, once Rector of Croston, and the only ever Bishop of Whalley, the Choir was originally formed as a visiting and training choir for the pupils of Bishop Rawstorne CE High School in Croston by Michael Sands, Director of Music at the School.
