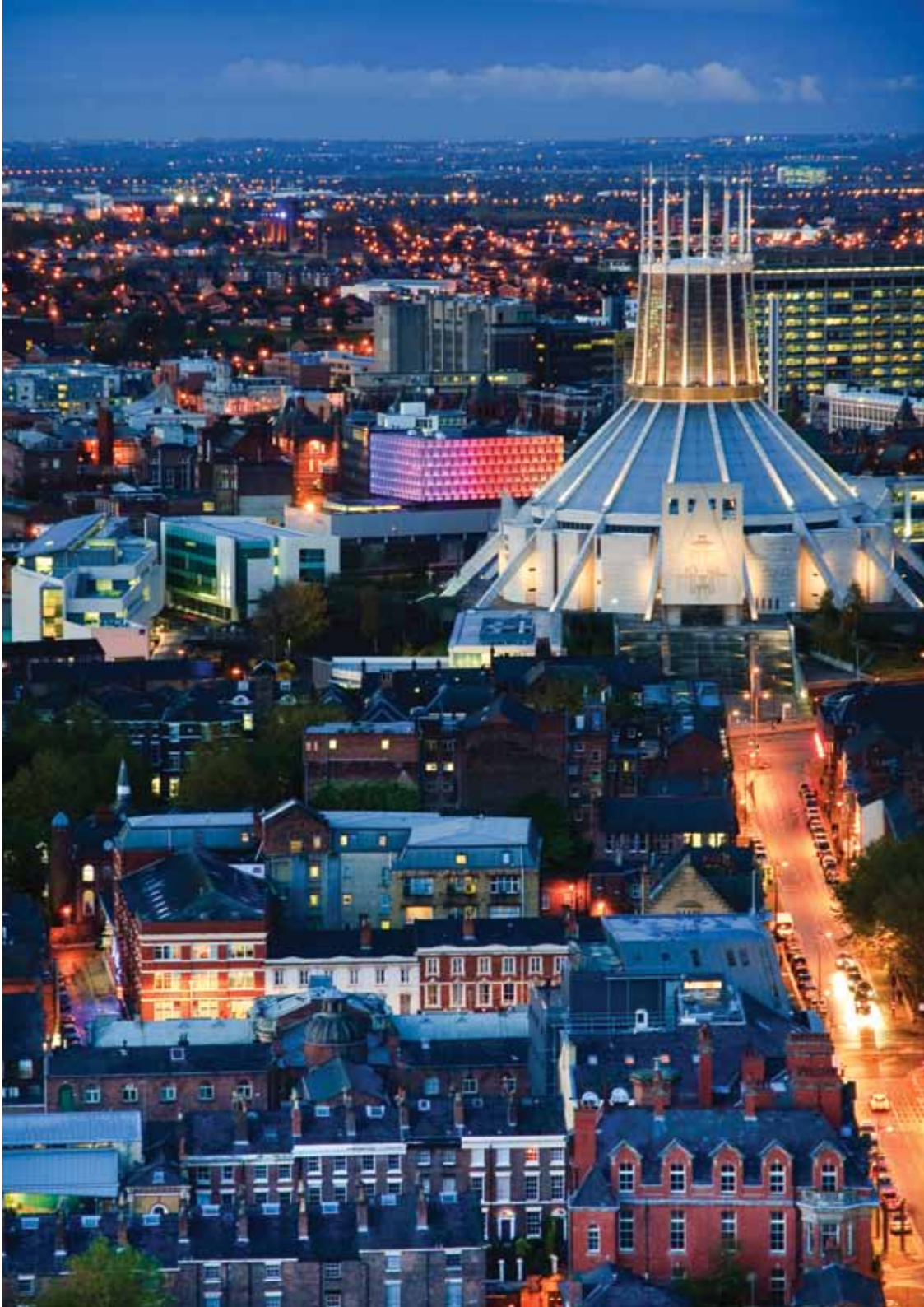

Shortly after the Crypt's completion however, rising costs and the Second World War forced the scheme's abandonment, and in its place was constructed the iconic Cathedral we know today, designed by Sir Frederick Gibberd. The original Crypt however, with its breathtaking scale and beautiful vaulted halls, remained hidden beneath as one of Liverpool's best kept secrets, until a recent £2 million restoration created a new visitor attraction and events space which now stands unparalleled anywhere in the region.



Aside from its unique aesthetics the Crypt is situated in the heart of Liverpool City Centre; it is 5 minutes drive from the M62; there are 12 hotels within 5 minutes walk; it is 30 minutes drive from John Lennon Airport, and 15 minutes walk from Lime Street train station. The Crypt has full disabled access and also boasts a 70 capacity underground car park, a centralised kitchen, a dedicated stage area, licensed bar, on site tables, chairs and tableware and state of the art public address facilities.

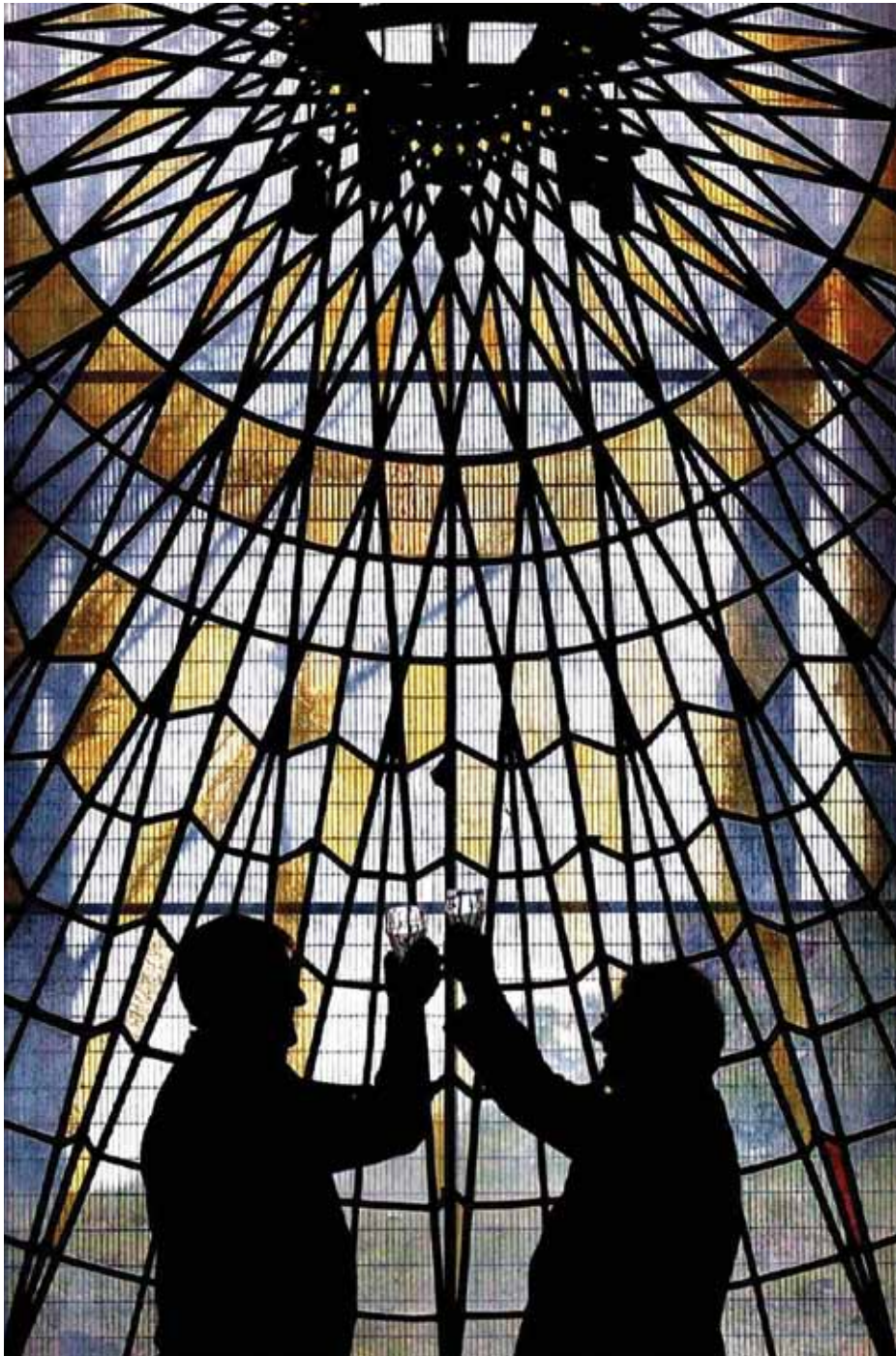

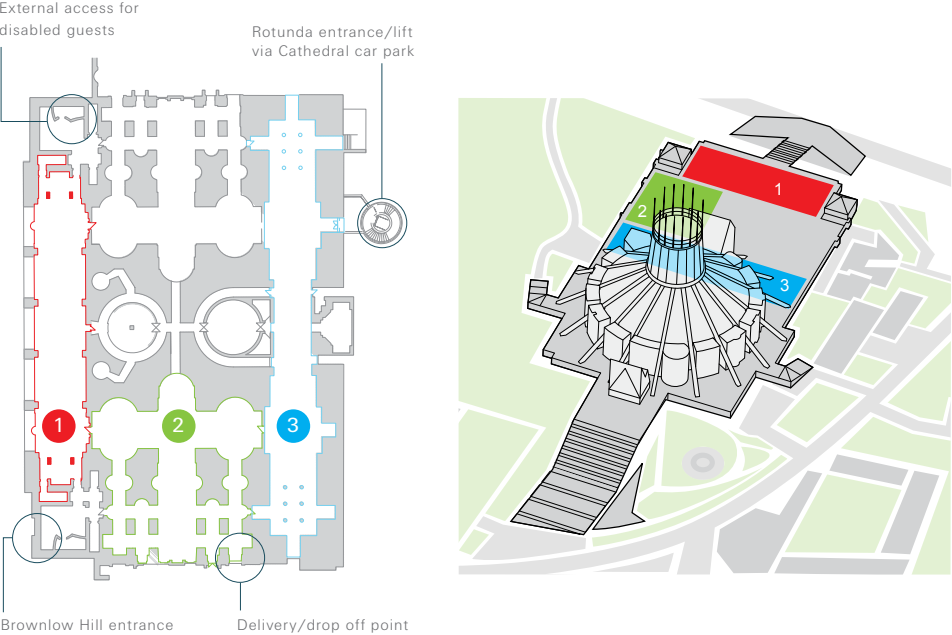

Liverpool CAMRA Beer Festival



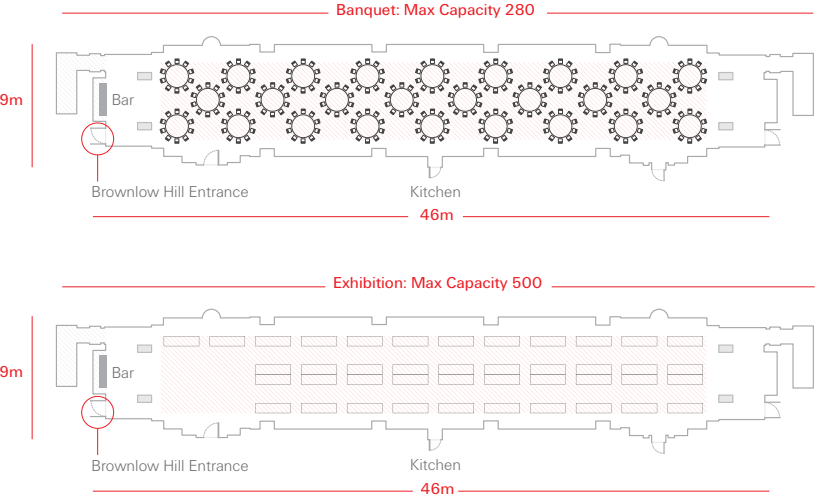

GREAT IDEAS FOR ROOM LAYOUTS



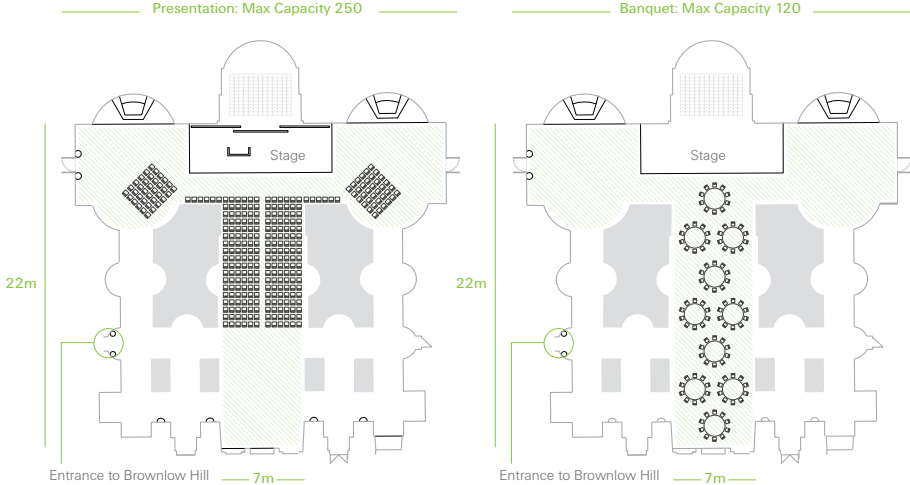
1 THE CRYPT HALL

The Crypt Hall can seat 280 diners. It is also ideal for exhibitions, as well as for academic use.



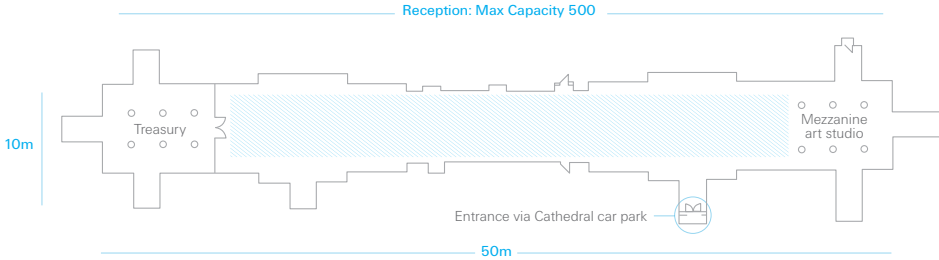
2 THE CONCERT ROOM

The Concert Room can accommodate audiences of up to 250 for conferences, lectures or performances, and up to 120 for dinner.



3 THE PONTIFICAL HALL

The Pontifical Hall is ideal for drinks receptions, and can hold up to 500 guests.
